

INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS

- The Community Based Medical Journal (CBMJ) agrees to accept manuscripts prepared in accordance with the "Uniform requirements for manuscript submission to the Biomedical Journals" approved by the International Committee of Medical Journals Editors.
- CBMJ is a peer reviewed journal published biennially in January and July by Community Based Medical College Bangladesh.

CONDITIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF MANUSCRIPT

- Original papers written in English will be considered for publication provided these have not been published previously and are not under consideration for publication elsewhere.
- All manuscripts are subject to peer and editorial review.
- Accepted manuscripts become the property of Community Based Medical College Journal.
- The author should obtain written permission and appropriate authority if the manuscript contains any table, data or illustration if previously published in other Journal. The letter of permission should be submitted with manuscript.
- If the photographs are used, permission from the patient or parents / guardians to print should accompany the manuscript. Otherwise identification will be blackened out.
- Rejected manuscripts / Electronic copies/ illustrations / photographs will not be returned to the authors.
- Editors are not responsible for courier/ postal failure.

PREPARATION OF MANUSCRIPT

- CBMJ welcomes original articles, review articles and case reports from qualified medical Doctors all over the World.
- Manuscript should be written in English and typed one side of A4 (290 × 210 cm) size white paper.
- Double spacing should be used throughout.
- Margin should be 5 cm for the header and 2.5 cm for the remainder.
- Style should be that of modified Vancouver.
- Pages should be numbered consecutively at the upper right hand corner of each paper beginning with the title page.
- Two copies of paper should be submitted. Authors are encouraged to provide in electronic form (disc) with adequate labelling.
- Manuscripts should be submitted in the following order in separate pages.

TITLE PAGE

The title page should contain :

- Title of the article should be concise, informative and self-explanatory.
- Name of each author with highest academic degree.
- Name of the authors with the department or institute where they are working.
- Name and address of the author to whom correspondence regarding manuscript to be made.

ABSTRACT

- Should be informative and limited to less than 200 words.
- Key words ≤ 5 should be provided for indexing.

TEXT

- The main text should appear in the following sequence: introduction, materials & methods, results, discussion, tables, legends for illustration, acknowledgements and references.
- Each section should begin in a new page.
- Generic names of the drugs should be used. For all quantitative measurements the international system of units (SI) should be used.

REFERENCE

- Reference should be in Vancouver style. Reference should be numbered in order in which they appear in the text. At the end of the paper the full list of references should be given with the names of all authors, unless there are more than 6, when only the first 3 should be given followed by et al. The authors names are followed by the title of the paper, the title of the journal is abbreviated. According to the style of Index medicus, year of publication, the volume number, and the relevant page numbers of the article should be given. Reference of books should be given the name of editors, places of publication, publisher, year and relevant page be included.

MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION

- The manuscripts should be submitted to the editor with covering letter, mentioning that the work has not been published or submitted for publication elsewhere. (Two hard copies & one disc)

- No part of the materials published in this journal could be reproduced, stored or transmitted without prior written permission of the editorial board.
